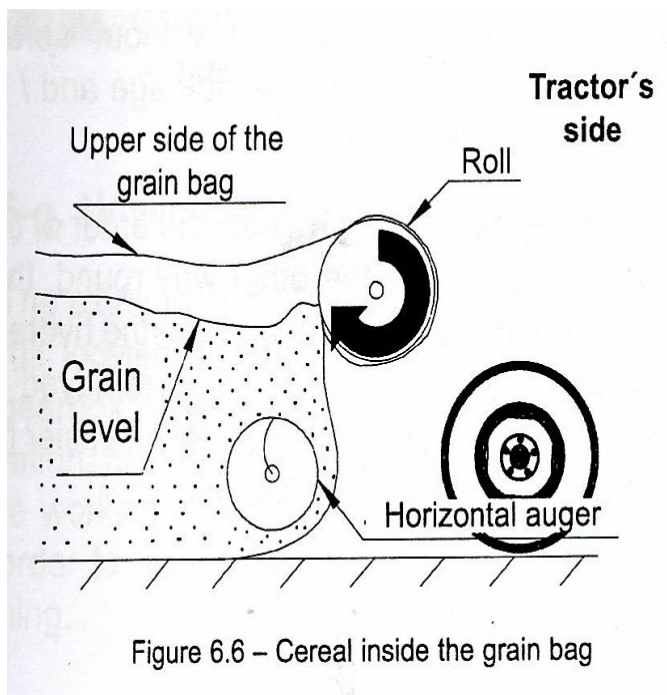

MERCHANDISE

Ensure that you set the roller speed to keep grain near the bottom of the roller. If you clear too much grain and the roller does not keep up, it will allow the bottom of the bag to lift up and come in contact with the bottom of the auger.

Be careful when altering height of the auger inside the bag, so that it does not **wedge** grain between the bottom of the bag and the auger. This may become an issue when you resume rolling up the bag as the bottom of the bag may be wedged under the auger and not roll up as required. Use height spaces as provided.



It is very important that you pull the bag up vertical to the roller. Please refer to figure 6.6 and the photo.
